2. Set up your Team Page

- 3. Name your team and set a goal. Upload a personal and team photo. Write a short note about why you are participating and why you formed your team. There is sample text available when you set up your page, but nothing is as powerful as telling your own story.
- 4. Set up your Personal Page with your personal goal. We recommend a personal goal of \$200.
