

# FIRST TIME APPLICANTS FOR CONNECTICUT I.D.

*What do you need to bring?*

A completed Connecticut ID Card Requirement and Application (Form B-230) - get form at the DMV office or online.

Document to verify your identity, you must show:  
U.S. birth certificate (original long form with stamp), out-of-state I.D. or driver's license, school ID.

Bring your social security card OR W-2 form

Proof of CT Residency: bring 3 pieces of mail (they have to be different). Documents need to show your full name, CT address, be typed and have been sent in the last 90 days. They can be utility bills, bank statements, pay stubs or school letters. If the mail is addressed to your parents they need to be at the DMV office with you.

If you are an immigrant with legal status in the U.S. bring your proof of resident alien identification card, green card, and or other documentation.

Money:  
Fee for first-time card - \$22.50.   
They accept cash, money orders, MasterCard or Visa credit/debit card or personal check (payable to "DMV"). If you live in a homeless shelter and can provide a proof of residency from a CT authorized shelter the ID card is free. Ask your shelter for a letter stating that you live there. Ask them to write your full name and the shelter's address.

*Where to go?*

To apply for a new Connecticut I.D. you **MUST** go in person. You can go to the following places. Plan to be there around 5 hrs (We know, it's long!). Mornings are the best times to go.
